Pennsylvania Partners in the Arts Program Stream Interim Application

Due date: January 15, 2020

PENNSYLVANIA PARTNERS IN THE ARTS PROGRAM STREAM DESCRIPTION:

Pennsylvania Partners in the Arts (PPA) Program Stream supports qualified applicants who provide artistic programming and/or arts services in Pennsylvania. PPA is a partnership between local organizations and the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts (PCA). Operating in all 67 Pennsylvania counties, PPA re-grants PCA funds to support a wide variety of local and community arts activities.

The 2020-2021 application is an Interim Application for organizations currently in Program Stream.

PPA PROGRAM STREAM ELIGIBILITY:

- Transition from Entry Track or PPA Project Stream, as approved by the PCA's governing council.
- An average fiscal size of less than \$200,000.
- Organizations must be nonprofit, tax-exempt corporations, a unit of government, or school district providing arts programming and/or arts services in Pennsylvania. Organizations are required to provide proof of incorporation and activity in Pennsylvania before applications are reviewed or funds awarded.

FUNDING PROCESS:

- Applications are submitted online through Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development's (DCED) website at <u>https://www.esa.dced.state.pa.us.</u>
- Partner staff review applications and address any concerns or questions.
- The Council annually reviews funding options and sets the parameters for funding. Awards are generally approved at the July Council meeting.
- Those receiving awards will be sent an electronic Grant Award Agreement (GAA). Recipients must log into <u>https://www.esa.dced.state.pa.us</u> to complete the GAA online & submit with electronic signatures. Once the PCA receives the GAA electronically, the award process begins.

- STEP 2. REGISTER and APPLY THROUGH https://www.esa.dced.state.pa.us.

STEP 3. SUBMIT ONLINE by January 15, 2020. No hard copies are required.
